The November minutes were reviewed. There was a motion by Leslie to accept the minutes. There was a second by Lynda. The minutes were approved.

Treasurer's report/Budget review: The November financials were presented by Sharon. Karen B. made a motion to accept the financials/budget and Lynda made a second. The November financials/budget were accepted. Pro Shop holiday gifts were suggested: Karla \$100, Coby \$100 and Angie \$50. A motion to approve all 3 gifts was made by Lynda, There was a second motion by Karen B for Karla's gift, a second motion for Coby's gift was made by Judy K. and a second motion was made by Sue O for Angie's gift. Tournament Chair: Leslie has a balance of \$397 at the end of the year. There was a total of 2252 players this season and 995 people were paid which was 44% of all members. MJ made a motion to raise the Best of the Best winner payout from \$25 to \$50, there was a second by Sue O. and the motion was passed.

Leslie reported the low net tournament went great. An email will go out to the qualifiers for Best of the Best on January 15th, 2026. ILGA Club Championship is coming up and sign ups will be done through Golf Genius.

State Medallion: The state medallion tournament is January 10th and 11th at Oakwood, Dari Akin is our gross winner and Julie Clausen is our net winner.

Membership: Jean reported there are 146 members as of today. There are 127 full members, 9 new members and 10 handicap only members. The February luncheon will celebrate the Best of the Best winner, Club Champion winner and the most improved Golfer, Judi Walker. The 2026 State Medallion winners will be honored at the February luncheon along with the Low Net Tournaments winners.

Luncheon/Home and Home: There are currently 30 ladies signed up for home and home the first week of January.

Ringers/Birdies: Cathy reported that session 3 is now completed and payouts are pending. Fourteen ladies have signed up for session 1 ringers through Zelle. There are a total of 52 ladies signed up for ringers and the deadline for session 1 signup was December 31st, 2025.

Pairings: Peggy is now overseeing pairings. Julie Clausen, Debbie Flinn and BJ Schuller are all helping out.

Website: Ann reported she updated the web site with photos of our “in memoriam” members. She will also be reviewing the web site content and work on uploading photos from our recent events.

Member/Guest: The event was a huge success with 56 teams competing, There were lots of raffle prizes with lots of winners. The raffle brought in \$1491. The Wednesday evening meet and greet and the ring toss were also very successful. A discussion was held on all the good feedback that was received and another discussion followed regarding things that need improvement.

The 2025 financial audit will be done in January 2026 by Barbara Senneff and one other volunteer.
