Official Score Cards and Golf Genius

Golf Genius is now used for scoring during all ILGA league play. **Please verify that the paper scorecard and Golf Genius scores match hole by hole before turning in**

the scorecard. All ILGA members should have the Golf Genius App loaded on their phones and be able to record scores. **After March 1st, if your paper scoresheet does not match the scores in Golf Genius, your pairings group will be disqualified from the game of the day.** If you are having trouble recording or correcting scores in Golf Genius, please do not hesitate to ask another member for assistance!
